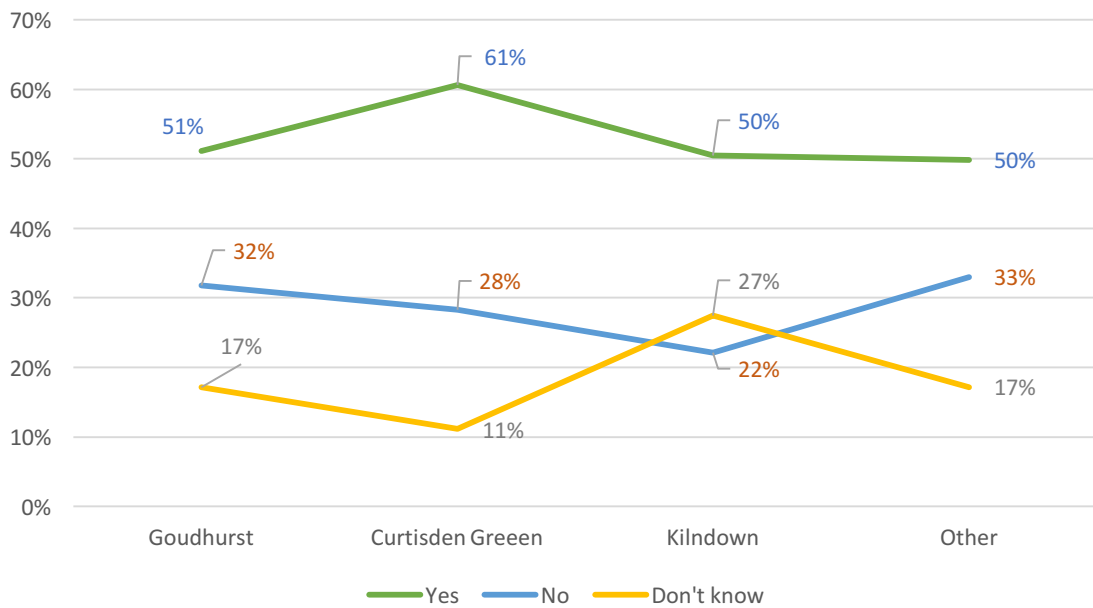
Do we need more houses in Goudhurst?



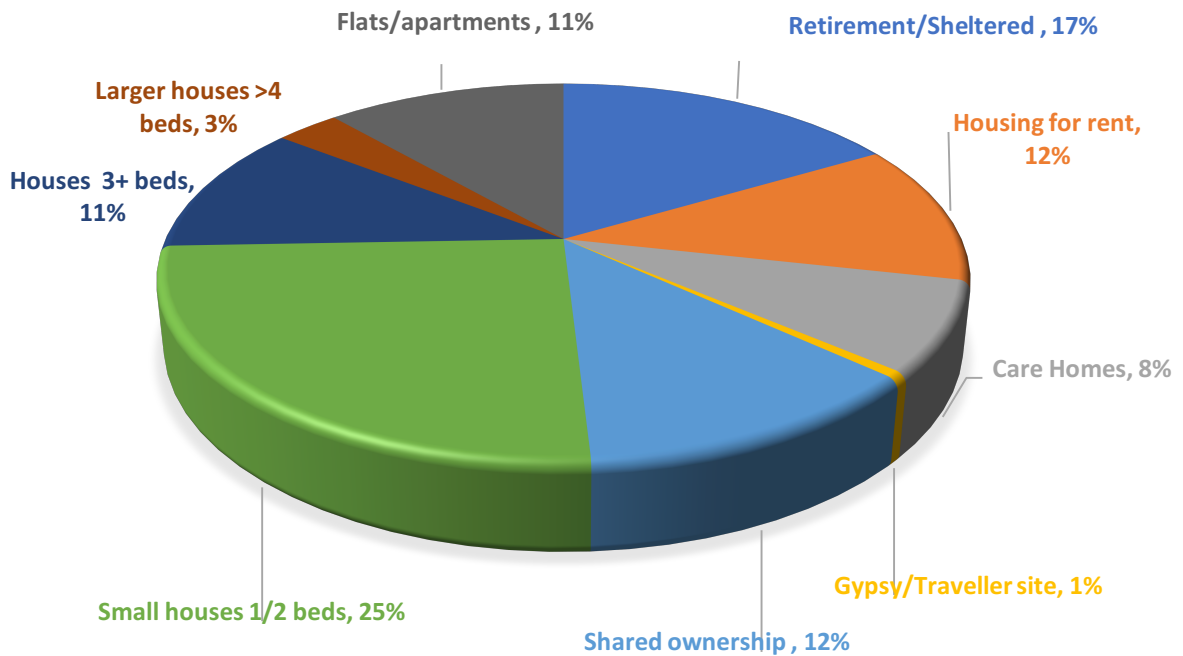
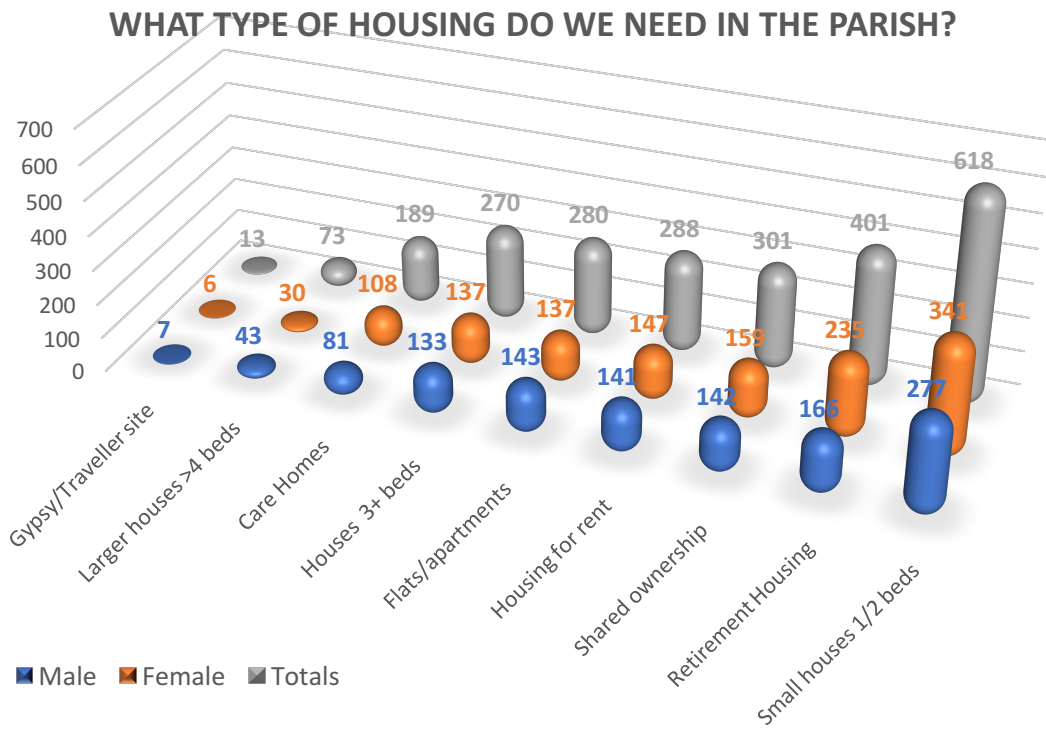
By age %



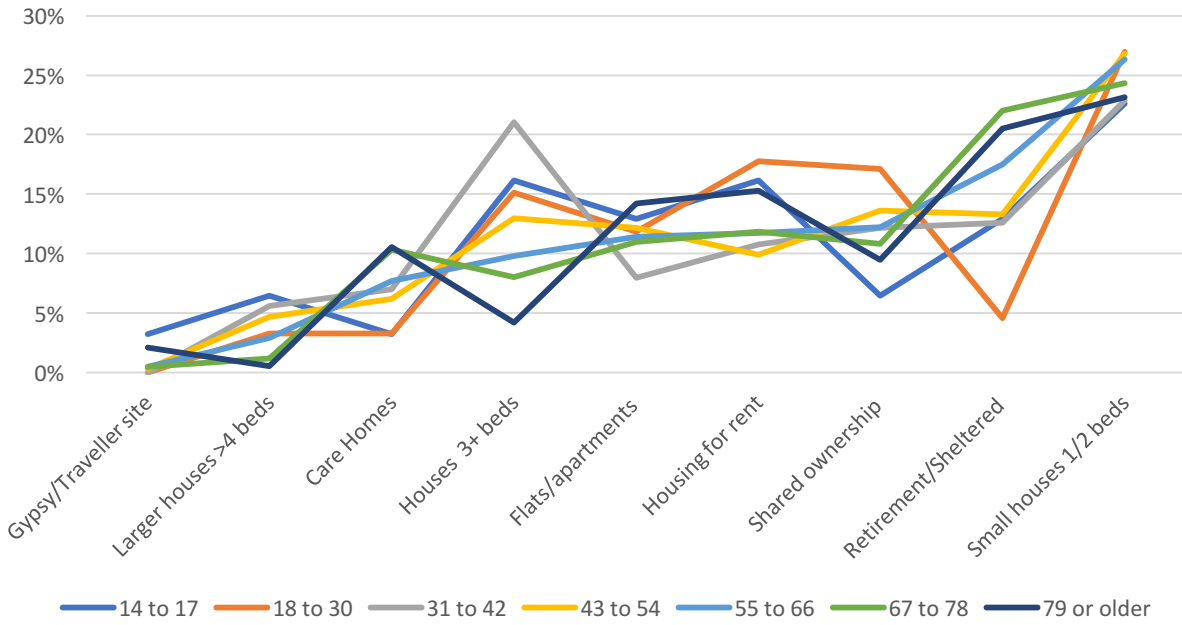
Need for housing by village



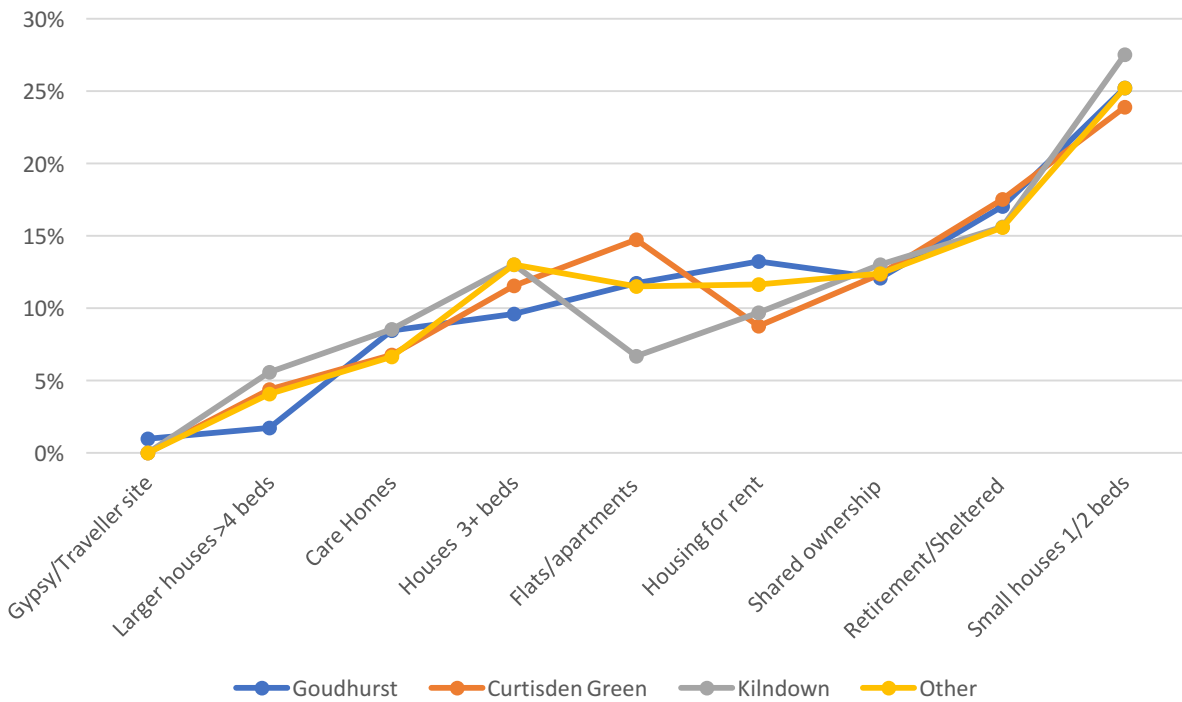
12. Which types of new homes do you think are most needed in the Parish?



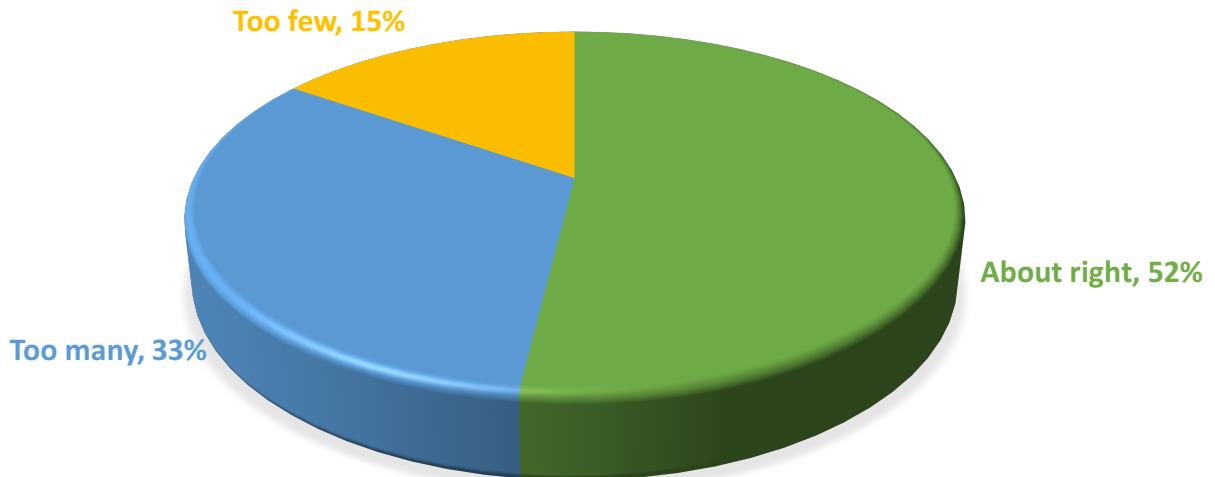
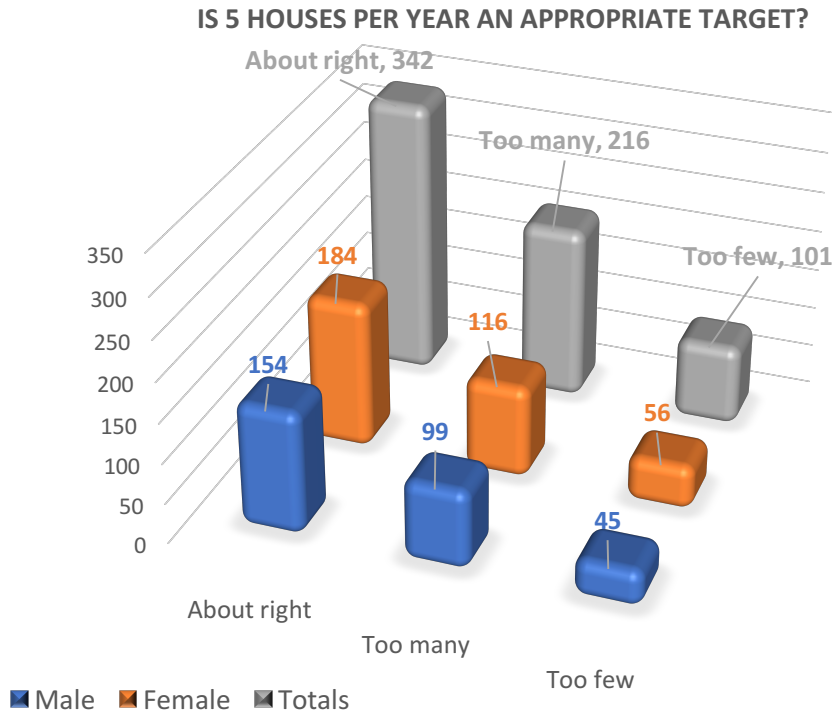
Housing type by age

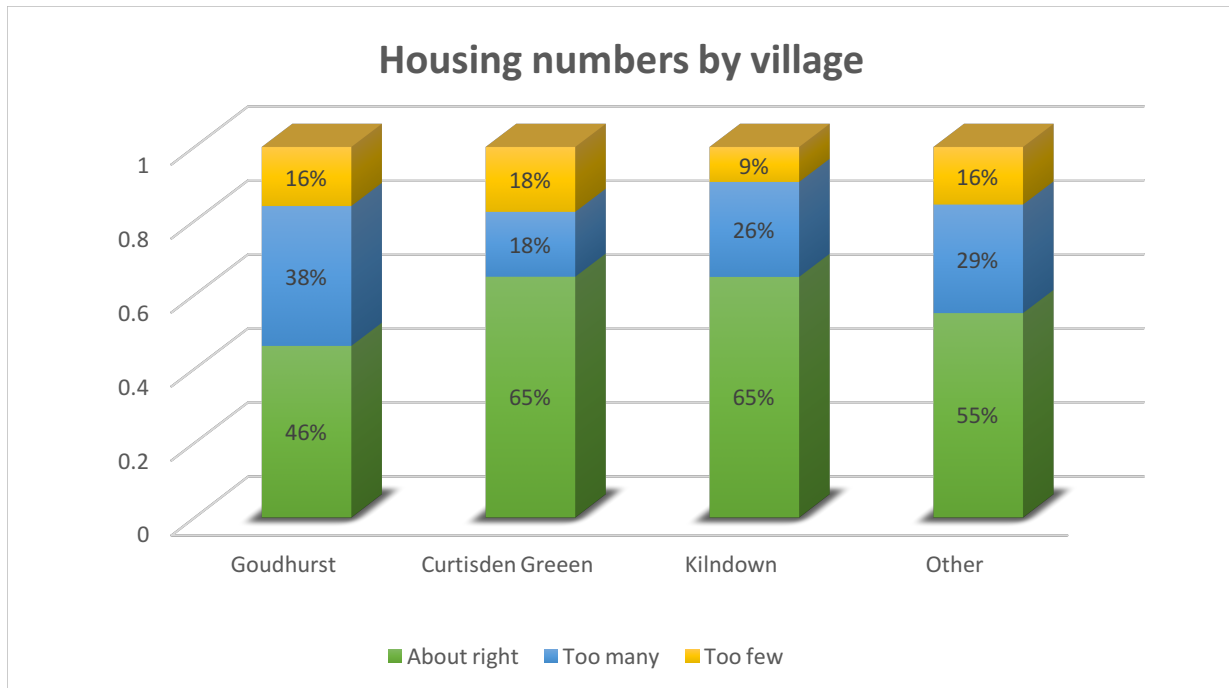


Housing types by community



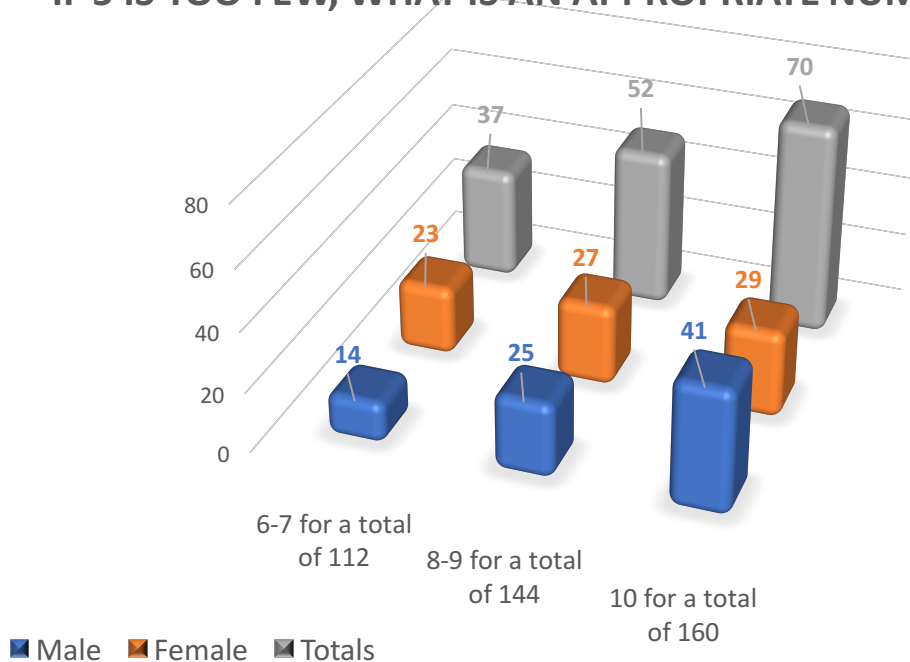
